In the spirit of transparency, this document explains the separate duties of the Pima County Elections Office and the Pima County Recorder's Office.

The Elections Office maintains custody of all ballots until the results are canvassed. Custody of the ballots is then transferred to the County Treasurer.
- Filing Office: for Petitions for Initiatives, Recalls and Referendums and Candidate Petition challenges

- Voter Registration
- Voter Roll list maintenance
- Mailing of Alternative Format Ballots: Braille, Large Print, etc.
- Early Voting: all voting before Election Day
- Oversees Early Voting Sites: Locations, days, hours
- Early Voting Site Worker Training
- Mail Ballot Drop Off locations
(Pima County Does Not have unstaffed ballot drop-off boxes)
- Emergency Voting
- Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)
- Signature Verification: Ballot Affidavits, Petitions for Initiatives, Recalls, Referendums, Candidates Petition challenges
- Ballot Status
(Until turned over to the Elections Office for tabulation)
